Charitable Trust awards grants to 501(c)(3) organizations in Illinois

- Funds for Charitable Trust come from filing fees 501(c)(3)s pay to the State of Illinois
- Preference to 501(c)(3) organizations located in economically depressed areas
- Preferences for organizations with operating budgets of up to \$1 million
- Grants are given up to \$25,000

How are Grants Awarded?

501(c)(3)s **submit applications** through the State Treasurer's Website



Committee meets to review applications and make final recommendations to the Treasurer



State Treasurer notifies grantees of final award

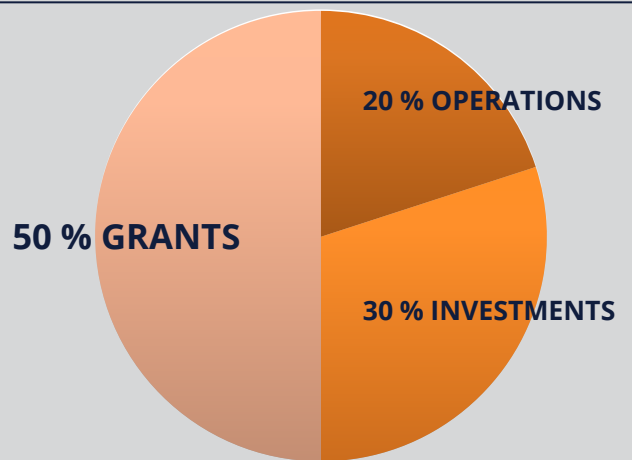
Charitable Trust Overview

The Charitable Trust Committee

An eleven member committee oversees the management of the fund and makes grant recommendations to the State Treasurer. The committee is made up of representatives from:

- State Treasurer's Office (Co-Chair)
- Attorney General's Office (Co-Chair)
- Lieutenant Governor's Office
- Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
- Department of Financial and Professional Regulation
- Six Private Citizens Appointed by the State Treasurer
